EPO (Emergency Power Off): this feature on UPS systems can cause many problems to the smooth running of the power protection installation. Primarily, the feature enables the UPS system to be 'made safe' in the event of an emergency.

Emergency Power Off (EPO) System refers to a critical safety mechanism within network infrastructure and other electrical environments, designed to quickly and completely shut down power in emergency situations.

Can an EPO Circuit stop an inverter?

Due to the economics of size and cost, in a number of cases operation of the EPO circuit may just stop the inverter. A typical example of a situation when there is a need to remove power to equipment in an emergency situation is in the case of fire. When the building is isolated, an output will continue until the batteries are exhausted.

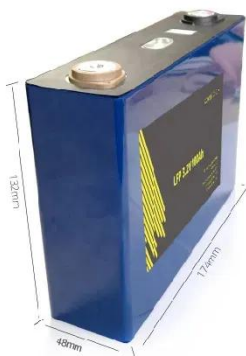
